

## Academic subject e-learning courses for Access to HE

Access to HE units are available for academic subject courses, and these can be included in a Diploma's Rules of Combination leading to the achievement of units. Alternatively, the courses can be used to supplement your existing teaching resources.

Each course can be used to supplement class-based teaching a part of a blended offer or could be used as a standalone part of an Access to HE course.

LASER Access to HE units are available for each of the courses along with sample assignments to enable students to achieve credits for the units if desired.

Tutors in colleges mark and provide feedback for the assignments, leading to the award of credit, just the same as students in classroom-based Access to HE courses.

The list below shows the courses/units that are currently available, and all units are at level 3 and are worth 3 credits unless otherwise stated.
