What is a Progression Agreement?

At Goldsmiths, we're committed to promoting access and diversity in higher education, which is reflected in the diversity of our student population. We also have a strong tradition of recruiting mature students, and those studying for less traditional qualifications. We have always valued the Access to HE Diploma as an academically strong qualification giving students a solid foundation for further study. For this reason, we have established Progression Agreements to support those studying Access to HE Diplomas accredited by LASER.

This Progression Agreement grants prospective students a guaranteed interview or offer to over 50 undergraduate courses at Goldsmiths!

In many cases, these offers are set one grade below the standard offer for the course, demonstrating our commitment to nurturing potential and our confidence in the abilities of those who access our university through an agreement.

The typical Goldsmiths Access to HE Diploma offer is a Pass with 45 Level 3 credits including 30 Distinctions with the remaining credits awarded at Merit/Pass. Under a Progression Agreement, we might ask for a Pass with 45 Level 3 credits including 21 Distinctions, 12 Merits and the remaining credits awarded at Merit/Pass in subject-specific modules.

Examples of the benefits offered

On the opposite page are just some examples of the benefits offered under the Progression Agreement. Over 50 undergraduate courses at Goldsmiths are a part of the agreement, with the majority offering students studying Access to HE diplomas guaranteed offers at one grade below standard.
