

## **Access to HE Diploma (Healthcare Professions) E-learning Options**

Did you know you could use LASER’s Access to HE e-learning to deliver a fully online Access to HE Diploma in Healthcare Professions?

This course provides the opportunity to enrol learners on a 100% distance learning course. The course however remains in the control of the Access to HE team in your centre who will be able to act as online tutors and assessors. LASER will externally quality assure the students’ work in the usual way.

Where a course is delivered either entirely, or nearly all, via distance learning, a college/Access to HE centre will be required to demonstrate that there are the proper resources in place to support this type of provision. 45 Credits must be chosen as graded from the Academic Subject list below and a further 15 may be chosen as ungraded credits from both the Academic Subject and Study Skills lists below:
