

## LASER Entry Level Award in Independent Living (Rights and Responsibilities) (Entry 1)

### Rules of Combination

To achieve the LASER Entry Level Award in Independent Living (Endorsed Pathway) (Entry 1), learners must achieve a minimum of 6 credits. 1 credit must be taken from Unit Group A, the mandatory unit. The 5 remaining credits must be taken from the units in Pathway Unit Group B. The choice of pathway in Pathway Unit Group B will determine the endorsement of the qualification. The learner must achieve a minimum of 4 credits at Entry 1. Units with the same title at different Entry Levels are not allowed. It is important to note that learners cannot mix and match units across Pathways.
