Assessment Guidance:

1.4 If no connection issues found, providing incorrect login credentials would support this for evidencing purposes.

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2.2 Assessment suggestion: provide a user persona with specific needs which can be accommodated by the browser accessibility settings (such as high contrast, text scaling, and audio support).

2.3 Could include: use of saving passwords; auto-fill information; homepage and new tab settings; and use of address bar search engine linking.

3.1 & 3.2 Assessment could include providing a scenario with specific requirements to support selection of the search techniques. Techniques could include use of:

- Explicit phrasing
- Exclusion of words
- Words in a title
- Specified file types

3.3 Academic referencing techniques may be appropriate.

4.3 Use online file sharing tools to collaboratively work on a single document. Evidence could take the form of a witness testimony in conjunction with supporting screenshots.

LO 5 Assessment could take the form of a presentation. Evidence could include a recording of the presentation; witness testimonies; and any additional notes prepared when planning the presentation.
