L.O 2: Domestic improvement tasks could include the following: changing a washer on a tap, replacing a ceramic disc cartridge on a tap, rewiring a plug, changing the fuse on a plug, repair a crack in a plastered wall, repairing a hole in either a hollow or solid core door, tiling a splashback on a sink/basin using tiles OR mosaic tiles, insulating a roof space, running a silicone bead between 2 surfaces (one of them tiled) or other similar tasks.
