ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

LASER does not stipulate entry requirements for this qualification, but learners must be aged 16 or over.

- Flexibility allows learners either to choose one specific health or social care profession to study in more detail or to opt for a generic pathway.
- 3 mandatory units:
 - Preparing for a Career in Health and Social Care Professions
 - Understanding (a named) Profession, or Understanding the Health and Social Care Professions
- Communication in Health and Social Care.
- At least 8 credits from the vocationally specific unit group must be completed.
