### **PRODUCT SUMMARY**

The LASER suite of First Aid qualifications comprises four regulated qualifications which have been developed by industry experts.

First Aid training is an important life skill as well as being a requirement in many workplaces. Employers must ensure that someone is always available to arrange first aid. Workplaces with certain levels of health and safety risks are likely to need a trained first aider. Schools, nurseries and other childcare settings are required by law to have a paediatric first aid qualified member of staff available.

The qualifications are valid for 3 years from achievement. An annual refresher is recommended to keep skills up-to-date.
